Minutes of the full council meeting of Colwick Parish Council, held in the Small Hall, Colwick Community Centre, at 7:00pm on Monday 16th March 2020.

Present: Cllrs Alison Nunn (Chair), Scott Handley

In attendance: 4 electors from the community, Notts County Cllr Nicki Brooks and Rev Amanda Digman

Apologies for absence: Cllr Meredith Lawrence (Vice-Chair), Cllr Femi Ogundipe

25. Due to reduced Councillors attending the meeting was postponed as the meeting was not quorate.

26. Due to the outbreak of COVID 19 and some guidance issued from central Government in the preceding days prior to the meeting there was some interest within the community to set up a community relief scheme to provide support for vulnerable residents in the parish. A group discussion took place about the feasibility of working with those willing to volunteer to help support the vulnerable. The discussions involved the methodology of whether the Parish could support this initiative by promoting it through posters in the community and attempting to identify those that are vulnerable. There were many considerations including the health and safety of the volunteers and whether the Parish could feasibly obtain appropriate DBS checks on the volunteers with short notice. The Parish Clerk had a discussion with the Leader of Gedling Borough Council Cllr John Clarke the following day regarding the possibility of Gedling Borough Council providing this assistance. Cllr Clarke confirmed this would be organised by Gedling Borough Council and advised the Parish to promote the initiative with local residents so the most appropriate residents could either take advantage of the assistance or offer to volunteer as appropriate. The Parish subsequently promoted Gedling Borough Council's 'Giving in Gedling' initiative to assist with the scheme.
